Items to Bring

- Clothes and undergarments for 6 days
- Scottish outfit (if desired, and if owned)
- Personal hygiene items such as toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, deodorant, comb/brush, shampoo and shower shoes.
- Sunscreen/ sunglasses, bug spray
- Pajamas and robe
- Comfortable shoes
- Light jacket or sweatshirt in case of inclement weather (The School of Music can be very chilly.)
- Umbrella
- Camera
- Chargers for phones, MP3 players, etc.
- Spending money
- Snacks (if you would like to have some of your own in your room.)
- Backpack or tote bag for traveling between the classes and your townhome.

- Alarm Clock
- Small mirror for room
- Sheets and Blankets for a *long twin* size bed *
- Pillow and Pillowcase *
- Washcloth and Towels *

- Fiddle and bow !
- **EXTRA FIDDLE for scordatura use** (extra violins may be available for those who are flying or for those who don't have a secondary fiddle.)
- Extra strings (for emergencies!)
- Rosin
- Auxiliary fiddle music if desired
- Music stand (for use outside of the School of Music, if desired)
- Recording device (optional)
- Pencils
- Manuscript paper (optional)
- \$20 keycard deposit

Townhomes come equipped with full kitchens & clothes washing facilities.

HOWEVER,

they do NOT come with items like plates, cups, mugs, silverware, paper towels, dishwashing soap, or clothes washing detergent.

You may bring these items with you, or, if needed, they can be purchased from the Rite Aid Pharmacy in New Wilmington. (It's walking distance.)

The camp townhouse (Bothy) WILL be stocked with two small coffee-makers, coffee, teas, lemonade, light snacks, and breakfast foods.

There is WIFI throughout campus. It may, however, be a little uneven in some areas.
